Dear Administrative Judges:

On October 4, 2010, the Board issued an Order directing the Staff to submit monthly status reports specifying the Staff's best estimate of the issuance dates for draft and final documents associated with its review of Powertech's application.

In its most recent Status Report, filed February 1, 2011, the Staff provided the following estimates:

Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS)

*June 2011*

Final Safety Evaluation Report (SER)<sup>1</sup>

*October 2011*

Final SEIS

*January 2012*

The Staff is presently engaged in consultation with a number of Tribes, including the Oglala Sioux Tribe, pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. The Staff is committed to addressing Tribal concerns, and the Staff will be meeting with Tribal representatives in order to promote effective consultation. Given the demands of consultation, the Staff has revised its estimates for issuance of both the Draft and Final SEIS.

With respect to its safety review, the Staff has scheduled a public meeting with Powertech on Thursday, April 7, 2011 to discuss responses to Requests for Additional Information (RAIs) that Powertech submitted to the Staff on December 23, 2010. The Staff's estimate for issuance of

the Final SER will need to be reevaluated after that meeting. It is difficult for the Staff to provide an updated estimate prior to the meeting. However, the Staff would alert the Board to the possibility that the Final SER may issue after October 2011.

The Staff's current best estimates are:

Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS)  
*December 2011*

Final Safety Evaluation Report (SER)  
*October 2011<sup>2</sup>*

Final SEIS  
*June 2012*

The Staff will provide updated estimates in its next status report, which it will file on April 1, 2011.
