Powertech (USA) Inc. (Powertech) would like to request an extension for our response to the P-2008-043 NOI MD-03 Fourth Review completeness issues outlined by DRMS in their letter to Powertech dated March 18, 2010. Powertech is awaiting approval from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for its Class V Underground Injection Control (UIC) Permit to re-inject produced pump test water. The EPA has indicated that the Class V UIC Permit will likely be issued by the end of August.

Powertech understands that as the late fall and winter months approach, freeze prevention may be required during the execution of water storage and re-injection techniques outlined in the NOI.
